## 2012 Lakeshore Summer Camps

**Child & Parent Camp – ages 5 – 9**                      **June 9-10**                      **\$66 each (\$132 for one child + one parent)**

All children need quality time with a significant adult in their life. This camp offers a great opportunity to do just that in a very active fun environment. Each adult attending w/child must complete a separate registration form and register as a camper.

**Primary Elementary – ages 7-9**                      **July 4-7**                      **\$165**

4 day-3 night camp for those first time campers or those just not ready to spend an entire week at camp. A great experience filled with everything from creekstomping, beach fun & crafts awaits and helps campers get ready for the week long camps.
